### **Description:**

The Ahoskie housing is a four-bedroom house (six beds) with a large kitchen, separate dining room and breakfast room, two full baths, two large dens, and utility room. The house has a large wrap-around porch, with swing, and nice backyard. The site is fully furnished.

The fireplace has functional gas logs. To operate: Press red button/knobs (located on opposite sides) at the same time and the pilot should light. The thermostat for the primary heat is in the hallway near the stairs. The house is air conditioned by window units upstairs and central air downstairs.

They work all hours of the night and need to be able to get in and out. Please make sure they are not blocked in and do not have to drive in the neighbors yard to get out.**

## **Directions**

From Greenville, take Hwy 11N for approximately 52 miles. Bear right on Hwy 42E. When coming into town on Highway 42/Academy Street, proceed through light by the hospital. Continue through 3 additional lights (corners Academy St. with Church, Main, and First Streets). Turn right on First Street. It is a large white house on the right hand side of the road. It has a wide gray front porch with white wicker furniture. The street number is on a small decorative sign on the right side of the house below the azalea bushes. A GPS may be helpful.
