

Child Mental Health for Primary Care: Scholarship for REACH Institute Patient Centered Mental Health in Pediatric Primary Care Virtual Training

Eastern AHEC and the NC AHEC Program are offering five scholarships to attend the REACH Institute *Patient Centered Mental Health in Pediatric Primary Care* virtual training. Eligible scholarship recipients must be primary care providers living and working in North Carolina. The scholarship will be awarded to five applications who may choose to attend one of the following trainings: February 4-6, March 11-13, or April 29-May 1, 2022. This training offers 28.25 hours of CME training including bi-monthly case consultation.

This training is \$2,200 per participant and will be completely covered by the scholarship. However, scholarship awardees will pay a deposit of \$200.00 which will be returned to you once you successfully complete the training. Preference will be given to rural providers. We ask you to assist the NC AHEC Program with future projects and professional development activities with the new knowledge and skills you acquire through participation in this training.
